Fundraiser story Isla's allergy walk

At just 8-years-old, Isla, a patient at the RVI's allergy unit, embarked on a 7-mile walking challenge from South Shields to Roker Pier. Her mission? To raise vital funds for the unit that provides her with exceptional care.

Isla's determination shone through, raising £1,800! She achieved this feat through her dedicated JustGiving page and a charity bucket she carried with her every step of the way.

Her inspiring efforts even caught the attention of local newspapers, which highlighted her incredible commitment. But Isla isn't stopping there - she's already planning a regular fundraising event.

Step-by-step setup guide:

- 1 Head to [justgiving.com/create-page](https://www.justgiving.com/create-page)**
- 2 Choose your cause:**
Newcastle Hospitals Charity
The Great North Children's Hospital
The Sir Bobby Robson Foundation
(All three use charity number 1057213)
- 3 Choose your activity:**
Whether you're taking part in an organised event, your own challenge, in memory of a loved one or just fundraising for a cause you care about.
- 4 Personalise it:**
Share your story and why you're fundraising.
Add photos of your challenge or inspiration.
Use your full name so friends and family can find you easily.

- 5 Set your target:**
This is an important bit. It will keep you and your fundraisers motivated. If you smash your target early - set a higher one - and be sure to share your success story with everyone who supported you.
- 6 Share share share:**
Don't be shy, share your page on special occasions, payday, take cash donations - everyone wants to support your amazing cause and don't mind being reminded about it. Be sure to tell people why you are raising funds for a cause you care about.
- 7 Stay connected:**
Add your postal address when prompted so we can keep in touch and cheer you on!

Ryan's Great North Children's Hospital fundraiser

"The Great North Children's Hospital is such an asset to the region and have helped countless families, including my own. My nephew suffered from Rhinovirus which led to him being induced into a coma and transferred to The Great North Children's Hospital, where he was put on a ventilator for a fortnight as his lungs were collapsing. COVID restrictions meant my sister was the only family member allowed in the hospital at the time, but she was not alone thanks to the incredible support she received from the staff while they delivered life-saving treatment for my nephew.

"Ever since my nephew's time in hospital I've had it in my mind that I'd like to fundraise to express my gratitude. I've ran the Great North Run several times but have never run a full Marathon before and it feels like a big enough challenge that I can hopefully raise a good amount for The Great North Children's Hospital. I'm excited for and terrified of the challenge in equal measure!"

We are so grateful to our fundraisers like Ryan who choose to support us and help us make a difference to the lives of thousands of children, young people, their families and staff at The Great North Children's Hospital."



Stephen's Sir Bobby Robson Foundation fundraiser

Stephen from Sunnyside, organises a group cycle ride each year with called Three Days for Bobby. Together they raise funds for The Sir Bobby Robson Foundation.

The distance and route vary, but the ride always begins from Sir Bobby's statue at St James' Park and takes three days to complete.

The riders come from across Tyneside and Teesside and have completed 12 rides already, including a very special ride to Eindhoven in Holland to mark 10 years of the challenge. Three Days for Bobby has raised over £57k for the Foundation.

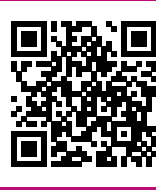
